Categories

Kata Individual kata for boys and girls aged 7–11 and U14.
Mixed Team Kata Mixed teams of boys and girls in the age groups 7–9, 10–11 and 12–13.
Kumite Individual kumite for boys and girls aged 7–11 and U14 with weight.

Rules

WKF Competition Rules and SKF Children's Rules apply. Repechage will be used in all categories.
All matches will be officiated by a full WKF referee panel. Flags will be used for kata and electronic scoring (joystick system) for kumite.

Equipment

Kata: Red and blue belts.
Kumite: Mouthguard, red and blue gloves, red and blue belts, foot and shin protection, helmet and approved external body protector.
U14: In addition to the equipment above, groin protection for boys and chest protector for girls are mandatory.

Entry fee

Free of charge for Swedish clubs affiliated with the Swedish Karate Federation (SKF). Foreign clubs: SEK 350 per individual category and SEK 800 per team.
